


CE Around the World

Youth Ministry Insight "Connect Planning with Purpose"

We believe youth ministry should result in youth maturing into the likeness of Christ in four relational dimensions – up with God, in with His family (the church), with other believers, and out in mission to the world. Ephesians 4:11-13 highlights this multi-dimensional discipleship purpose as:

- Up become mature
- In body of Christ may be built up
- With until we all reach unity
- · Out for works of service
