Youth Ministry Insight Making our Youth Active Participants

Youth are meant to be active, not passive, participants in the family of God (1 Cor. 12; James 1:22). This is why, from the very start, Christian Endeavor has engaged youth in meaningful service. Just one week after the movement was founded, Henry Pennell, a mature eleven-year-old, led the second prayer meeting! Of this moment, F. E. Clark (founder of CE) declared, "I desired to emphasize the fact that this was a young people's society, and that a lad could lead a meeting."

Activating youth to serve means youth ministers (whether volunteers, lay leaders, pastors, or parents) take the role of a coach rather than a star player.

Empower youth to prioritize participation by training them to actively serve through four key teams (committees) in your youth ministry:

- The Teaching Team
- The Events Team
- The Hospitality Team
- The Missions Team
